C-R Productions Receives 2008/9 Award

On August 12th, 2009, Tony Rivera, Director accepted a 2008/9 Award from The Rotary Club of Cohoes for C-R Productions.

Tony Rivera began his remarks by stating that the Cohoes City Music Hall has been reopened for 8 years, and that last year (September 2008 to June 2009) over 40,000 people attended shows and events there.

C-R Productions also offers education and outreach programs for children. This summer they conducted <u>Musical Theatre Summer Camp</u> from July 27 - August 7 at the Cohoes Music Hall at which participants had an opportunity to play, act, sing and dance.

The December 9th, 2009 performance of Beauty and the Beast will be a <u>District 7190 Rotary Foundation Annual Event</u>, and is an exclusive Rotary performance. All proceeds will be donated to the Rotary Foundation. Tony stated that he would like the Rotary Club of Cohoes to have a strong presence. He also stated that Harriet Noble is co-chair for this event. If any one knows of any local businesses who would like to contribute to a Silent Auction, to be held prior to the show, please let Harriet know.

Tony also explained C-R Productions received a \$10,000 grant through the Leon J. Goldberg Foundation to fund <u>C-R Generations</u>. This is an intergenerational program designed to connect children, ages 5-18 and senior citizens utilizing the arts. It will begin this fall. C-R Productions has also been discussing with Keith Hornbrook of the Cohoes Senior Center in this regard.
